**BYLAW NO. 3084, 2013**

**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A MUNICIPAL TAX COLLECTION SCHEME  
ESTABLISHING PENALTIES TO BE APPLIED IN RELATION TO PAYMENTS MADE  
AFTER A TAX DUE DATE ESTABLISHED BY THE BYLAW**

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**WHEREAS** the *Community Charter* sets the general tax collection scheme;

**AND WHEREAS** it is the intention of Council to create an alternative tax collection scheme under the *Community Charter*;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council for the Corporation of the City of Duncan enacts as follows:

1. Administration:

1.1 If all or part of property taxes for the current taxation year for the parcel of land and its improvements on the assessment roll remain unpaid after the last working day in September of the year those taxes are levied, the Collector will add to the said unpaid property taxes a penalty equal to 5% of the portion that remains unpaid.

1.2 If all or part of property taxes for the current taxation year for a parcel of land and its improvements on the assessment roll remain unpaid after the last working day in October of the year those taxes are levied, the Collector will add to the said unpaid property taxes an additional penalty equal to 5% of the portion that remains unpaid (this penalty applied against the penalty charged in accordance with Section 1.1)).

1.3 The penalties referred to in Section 1.1 and 1.2 are due as part of the property taxes for the current year for the parcel of land and its improvements.

1.4 Under *Community Charter* Section 235 (2), property owners may elect, by giving written notice, during the twelve month period ending May 15<sup>th</sup> of the current year, to pay under the general tax collection scheme.

1.5 Interest on taxes in arrears and delinquent taxes will be charged in accordance with the provisions of the *Community Charter*.

1.6 The rates and taxes established under the annual Tax Rates Bylaw are due and payable on or before July 2nd of each year.
